Arsenal CU teams up with a local business on a community-minded project

When officials at Arsenal Credit Union (Arnold) were approached by a local business owner about participating in a local toy drive during the past holiday season, the decision was an easy one to make.

"Helping the community is what we're all about," said Arsenal VP Ken Moser, "and we have a soft spot in our hearts when it comes to supporting causes involving kids."

Employees and members at Arsenal brought in more than enough toys to overstuff a large collection box that had been dropped off at the credit union's main office in Arnold by Allen Coggins, owner and president of Home Maintenance and Contracting, Inc. All of the toys were picked up by Coggins on Dec. 18 and distributed to needy children in Jefferson County through the Toys for Tots program, which was organized locally by the Jefferson County Business Network.

Arsenal helps kids throughout the year by contributing to Children's Miracle Network; all money raised benefits the young patients at Cardinal Glennon Children's Medical Center and St. Louis Children's Hospital. In addition, the credit union helps to prepare children for the future by providing free financial education at area schools.

Arsenal Credit Union has five branches in the St. Louis area, including its headquarters in Arnold, and serves those who live or work in Jefferson County, St. Louis City, and St. Louis County.
